Admissions

Degree Requirement of Master of Science:

- A minimum of two core courses have to be completed from the elective courses.
- A minimum of 30 graduate level credits must be completed, which must include 4 semesters of the Department
- A master thesis worth 6 credits is required but do not count towards the minimum credit requirements.
- A committee will conduct final oral examination on the thesis research.

Degree Requirement of Doctor of Philosophy:

- A minimum of two core courses have to be completed from the elective courses.
- A minimum of 24 graduate level credits must be completed, which must include 4 semesters of the Seminar.
- A successful qualifying examination is required.
- A Ph.D. dissertation worth 12 credits are required but do not count towards the minimum credit requirements.
- A minimum of 2 international SCI journal publications is required.
- A successful English qualifying examination is required.
- A successful open oral defense examination is required.

- 2. Deadline: March 30th for fall semester 2020, October 10, 2020 for spring semester 2021
