3 Eligibility	<p>Applicants participating in this program must be full-time students of the home institution.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Master or Doctoral graduate students * Undergraduate students in their final year * English Language Proficiency: TOEFL (iBT) 70 or above, TOEIC 650 or above (or, Japanese language proficiency is at the "intermediate" level or above.) * Applicant for the program is required to satisfy the academic requirements normally imposed by Tokyo Tech on its own students.

<p>5 Nomination & Selection Process</p>	<p>Preliminary nomination of two (2) students with priority order is made by NCKU, and a “Nominee List” with priority order and other required documents are sent to an AOSU Program Office at Tokyo Tech.</p> <p>Nomination Deadline: January 5, 2023</p> <p>Selection and admission of up to two (2) students is notified to the home institution by late January 2023.</p>

Verification of Student Status at Home University in English (PDF) (clarifying it duly covers the entire exchange period) 4. Official Test Result of TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, or equivalent document (PDF) (for non-native English speakers) 5. Copy of Passport (PDF) 6. Research plan in less than 500 words in English 7. <p>7 Academic Supervisor</p>	<p>Tokyo Tech will assign an academic supervisor for each exchange student in consideration of the student's study plan.</p>
<p>8 Research Evaluation</p>	<p>Tokyo Tech supervisor will provide a short evaluation of the research project undertaken by exchange student at the end of the exchange to enable the home institution to decide on appropriate credits, if appropriate.</p>
<p>9 Admission, Application, and Tuition Fees</p>	<p>Waived under Program Agreement</p>

<p>12 Accommodation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Students are responsible for paying their own accommodation and rent fees. · The program will make efforts to arrange a Tokyo Tech dormitory room for AOSU students. But, we cannot guarantee rooms for everyone. We will notify students of the allotment results and details one month before the starting date. Room change requests after the allotment will not be accepted. Please note that students should prepare an alternative housing plan in case they are not admitted into our dormitory. · Tokyo Tech will assist AOSU students in this process by introducing potential options. 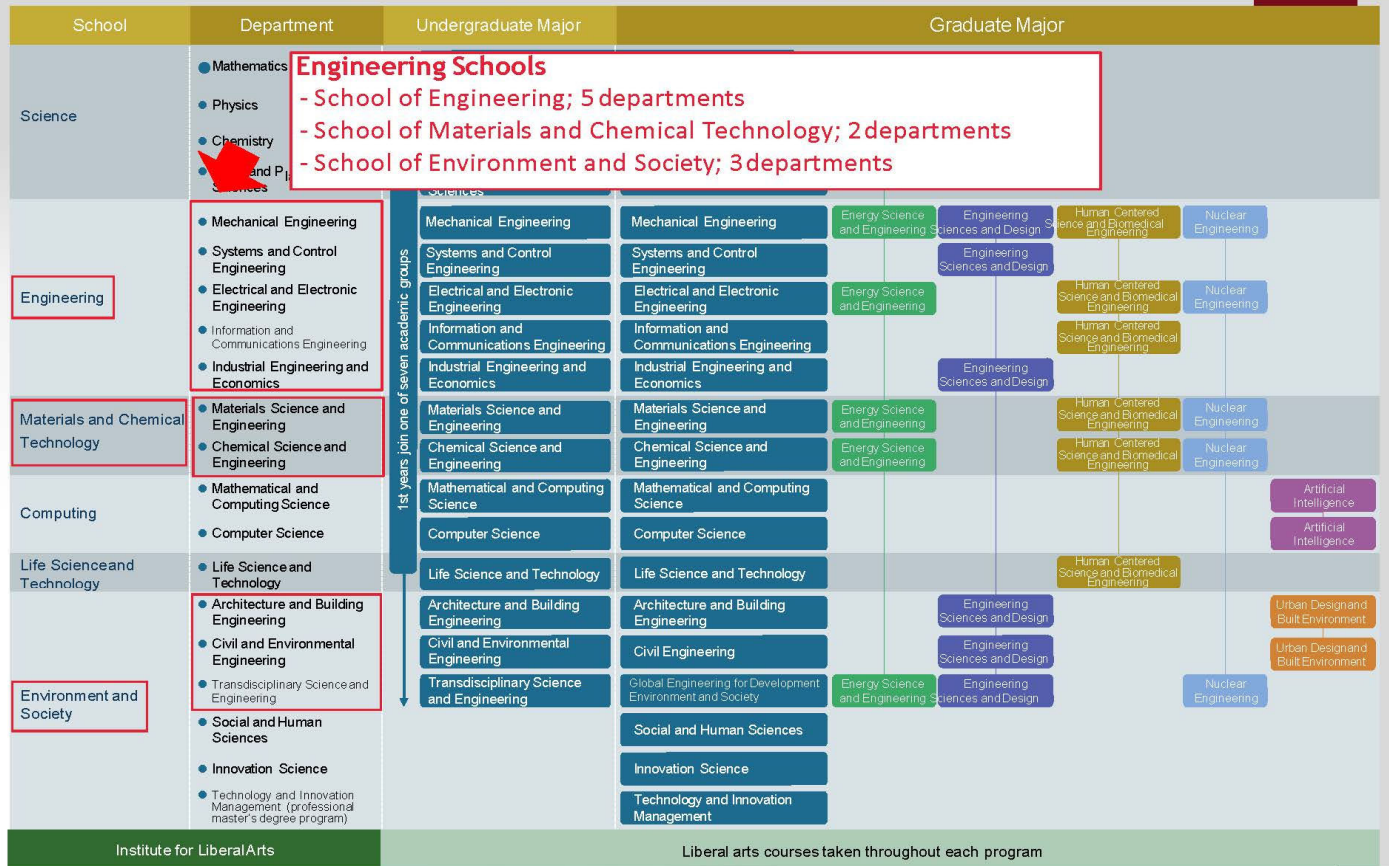
